MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL ORIENTATION AND OPEN HOUSE

6th Grade Orientation and Open House

The 7th through 12th-grade open house will follow an open format. After receiving a copy of your schedule from the tables in front of the auditorium, you can visit classrooms and meet teachers in any order you wish.

ELEMENTARY MEET AND GREET INFORMATION

Our elementary Meet and Greet will be held before the start of the school year this year. Like we have done in the past, our Scottie 3s, PreK, and Kindergarten will have separate orientations to help those students become familiar with their new routines.

We will also hold a separate Meet and Greet for grades 1 & 2 and grades 3, 4, 5 due to the change in structure for our 3rd and 4th graders (a Parent Square message was sent out on 7/29/2024 to all current 3rd and 4th graders). We know it can be difficult to have the Meet and Greets on different nights, but we wanted to be sure parents with children in grades 3, 4, and 5 could attend to hear the information on departmentalization.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP INFORMATION

Middle/High School

If you plan to drop off your student, please do not do so before 7:30 am. Students must be in their 1st-period class by 7:50 am, or they will be considered tardy. Students who are dropped off at school should be dropped off in the back of the school at Door #19. Students may be picked up after school in the back of the school as well. Middle/High school dismissal is at 2:52 pm.

*During the school day, you may drop off/pick up students at the front door (Door #1)



Elementary

Drop-off for elementary students will begin at 8:15 am. No students will be permitted to be dropped off before this time. Elementary drop-off and pick-up will be in the front of the building. Please pull into the drop-off and pick-up line off Scotland Lane and follow the painted lines in front of the field house by the football field. Elementary dismissal begins at 3:25 pm.

*This same procedure is used during the school day.

HOME ACCESS CENTER
